Asansol Durgapur Development Authority

Apart from the Urban Local Bodies of Asansol Municipal Corporation, Durgapur Municipal Corporation, Jamuria, Raniganj and Kulti Municipality the government has set up Asansol Durgapur Development Authority in this region for planned and scientific management of growth. ADDA or Asansol Durgapur Development Authority was established under the West Bengal Town and Country (Planning & Development) Act 1979, (West Bengal Act XIII of 1979) merging the Asansol Planning Organization, Asansol (estd. 1964) and the Durgapur Development Authority, Durgapur (estd. 1958) from 1st April 1980. The Asansol Durgapur Development Authority has been spearheading the cause of industrial, infrastructural and other development activities under its jurisdiction, which extends from Panagarh to Barakar with a total area of 1615.90 sq. km. covering about 30 lakhs of both rural and urban population.

Acting as a change agent for infrastructural growth and technological advancement, ADDA is busy giving shape to a host of industrial estates, growth centres, and industrial and residential townships. Some major achievements are visible in the developing quality urban infrastructure in the region. ADDA has given special emphasis on development of Infrastructure in its planning area with a view towards overall urban renewal.

The two most important growth centers of this region are Durgapur and Asansol

Established as the 'steel city' of the east, Durgapur has today grown beyond any other city in West Bengal. While retaining its essential character as a clean and green city, it presently witnesses a boom in the educational, retail, hospitality, housing, entertainment and knowledge industry sectors, offering entrepreneurs in these fields all the requisite infrastructure. Durgapur is one of the prime movers in the changing face of Bengal, and is the best alternative to any crowded metro in the country.

Asansol, now established within the first 10 fastest growing cities in India, has been well-known trade center in the region for over a century. It was established as an industrial city much before any other in this region. Till date it remains a major attraction to heavy industry due to its location and access to raw material like coal, iron-ore, etc.

The location advantage of Asansol Durgapur region has increased with the 4 lanning of NH-2. With its base of raw material, skilled labour, location and basic infrastructure, Asansol-Durgapur certainly forms one of the most attractive destinations for industries from Steel to IT / ITES and retail. The region has seen a phenomenal growth in the past decade and ADDA has collaborated with all growth oriented organizations in the area to ensure that it is planned scientifically.

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Asansol Durgapur Planning Area – Opportunities and Challenges

The Asansol Durgapur Planning region has certain basic infrastructure in place, which makes it an ideal destination for both heavy, process and knowledge industry. The urban character is attractive to retail and housing. The region offers multi-dimensional growth opportunities for any investment.

EDUCATION :

This region is home to various quality educational institutions in terms of schools and technical colleges, ITI's, polytechnic, etc. Vocational Education has always been important to this area. Recently, a number of Law Management, Hotel Management and Engineering Colleges have treated themselves in this region, creating the ample base for the future requirement of skilled manpower. INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY :

During the recent times there has been a special emphasis on the promotion of the development of Information Technology in Asansol Durgapur Planning Area. Land has been provided to some major IT/ITES companies, viz.

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Among them Pinnacle Infotech and Hinduja TMT have established a good business based on local employment. Apart from these, ADDA has provided land to Software Technology Park of India where an Earth Station and an Incubation Centre for IT Sector has been set up. WEBEL Technology Ltd. has also started one finishing school at Durgapur to meet the requirement of the IT Sector in the area. In its attempt to bring about a major development of IT Sector in the area, ADDA has recently entered into Public Private Partnership Project for an IT SEZ in the Bidhanagar area of Durgapur. Shapoorji Pallonji Company Ltd. is the Private Partner of ADDA in the venture on 25 acres of land. The MoA in this regard has already been executed and Govt. has been moved for SEZ clearance.

HEALTH FACILITIES :

Asansol Durgapur Development Authority has recently taken up the project of establishment of one Super Specialty Hospital with all allied facilities and a Medical College at Durgapur. Land for the purpose has already been allotted to the SPS Synergy Foundation for this purpose. Medica Synergy is setting up a trauma center at Asansol. ADDA is also making more efforts to bring in quality investment in this section in Durgapur and Asansol.

INDUSTRIAL SCENARIO :

Industrial activities have been the key to the economic development of the area. The major existing industries are Durgapur Steel Plant, IISCO Steel Plant, Alloy Steel Plant, Alstom Boilers Ltd, Durgapur Projects Ltd., Damodar Valley Corporation, Birla Cement, Ultra Tech Cement, GECL and ECL. To promote industrialization, Asansol Durgapur Development Authority has set up three industrial areas at Durgapur and one each at Mangalpur and Jamuria and at KSTP in Asansol where many number of small and medium scale industries are functional. Asansol Durgapur Development Authority has also developed one Export Promotion Industrial Park under the sponsorship of Ministry of Commerce, Govt. of India to provide high standard facilities for export oriented industries in this region. It is a 148 acre park situated on NH-2 near main Eastern Railway Line with all basic infrastructures. ADDA is also planning acquisition of land in Durgapur and Asansol region for industrial development.

POWER SUPPLY :

Asansol Durgapur & its adjoining area have an installed capacity of around 3500 MW along with Mejhia TPS of DVC and Bakreshwar TPS of WBPDC. DVC has already started work on its 1000 MW TPS at Andal, which is scheduled to become operational in 2010. DPL shall be adding 8th unit of 300 MW capacities. DPSC has planned to bring in 250 MW units in its Dishergarh Thermal Power Station in three years from now and then another 250MW 1¹/₂ years after first one.

- The region is power surplus and additional large generation units are being added continuously to take care of rapid industrialization.
- DVC is servicing a contract demand of about 400 MVA for its H.T. Industrial Consumers.

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- DPL is already distributing 400 MW in its command area in Durgapur, bulk of which is given to industries. Only 15 to 20% is going for public distribution. Distribution network is being modified to supply power to upcoming Industrial and Commercial Units from its 300 MW 7th unit.
- Asansol & Durgapur divisions of WBSEDCL together are distributing around 200 MVA of power, around 40% of which is going to Industrial Consumers.
- Dishergarh Power Supply Company is handling around 170 MVA, which is mainly distributed to Collieries and Industries.
- This region has a well-laid Transmission Grid network at 132 KV and 220 KV levels. Networks from all power producers are connected with each other and to WBPDC grid,
- Towards improving hydrothermal mix and for proper peak load management, 900 MW Purulia Pumped Storage Project of WBPDC has been commissioned recently. This plant is pumping water from a lower reservoir to high level reservoir when power is surplus in the grid and utilizing the elevated water to produce power up to 900 MW to manage the load at peak hours.
- WBPDC grid is also connected with the Eastern Power Grid to bring in stability of power supply.
- Power tariff is among the lowest in the entire country.

AVAILABILITY OF WATER :

At present, the region is dependent mainly on surface water available from the systems developed on rivers Damodar, Barakar and Ajoy for both domestic and industrial use. In Durgapur area, water is available from the barrage pond. Water is also made available from infiltration wells/ pumps on riverbeds. Total installed capacity of domestic water is 59.62 million gallons daily, which excludes the water available to the public sector company townships through their own installations. Installed capacity of industrial water is 132.43 million gallons per day. The eastern part of the region has potential ground water and in the western part, there is possibility of utilizing the water from abandoned mines.

Major water supply project of JNNURM are under process.

- Durgapur Municipal Corporation – 7 MGD
- Asansol Municipal Corporation – 10 MGD
- Jamuria Municipality – 5 MGD
- Raniganj Municipality – 42 MLD

RESIDENTIAL DEVELOPMENT :

Asansol Durgapur Development Authority has established two major residential townships at City Centre and Bidhannagar to accommodate the demand for residential houses in the area in Durgapur. Through a joint venture project with Bengal Ambuja, it has already established one township “URBASHI”. The extension of Urabashi area is presently being developed by ADDA. ADDA has also come up with Joint Venture Residential-cum-Commercial Project with Bengal Shristi Infrastructure Development Ltd. at City Centre Durgapur and Kalyanpur, Asansol an exclusive residential project with Bengal Greenfields, also at City Centre.

ADDA has taken up plotted development in Asansol in the Kanyapur Sattelite Township. The running projects with Bengal Shristi (JV) and Sugam Park (PPP) are also currently under implementation.

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HOSPITALITY & HOTELS :

The area is developed in Hospitality sector for existence of two Three Star Hotels, viz, Peerless Inn and Ginger. Apart from them there are any many quality hotels like City Residency, Pritika, Pathik Motel, etc. Durgapur is also rich in guest-houses of different major companies like Durgapur Steel Plant, ABL, PCBL, DPL, ADDA, etc. There are also many upcoming hotels for which ADDA has provided land. The construction work of some of them is already in progress.

The hospitality sector being slightly underdeveloped in Asansol, ADDA is specifically encouraging investment in the hospitality sector in Asansol. One 3 star hotel on NH-2 by-pass is already under construction.

RECREATION AND ENTERTAINMENT :

Apart from Kolkata, Durgapur Asansol region is considered to be the most developed area in recreation and entertainment. It has three major shopping malls viz. the Big Bazaar (City Centre), Suhatta (with Spencers) and the City Plaza. There is also one multiplex in the name of 89 Cinemas. Asansol Durgapur Development Authority is presently constructing another recreational-cum-commercial hub with multiplex named JUNCTION. The South of NH-2 opposite City Center is also being developed as a commercial hub by ADDA.

In Asansol, ADDA has taken up a Public Private Partnership Project with Srijani for a Mall with Multiplex facilities. Beside small malls are also under construction in Asansol offering good entertainment and restaurant facilities.

CULUTURALAND RELIGIOUS :

Place of Interest

Kalyaneswari Temple :

Situated at a distance of about 23 Kms. from Asansol, Buses, Mini Buses and Taxies are always available. ADDA has taken up a project to set up a pilgrim center near it.

Jaidev Kendule :

Birth place of vaishab poet Sri Jaidev is situated by the side of river Ajoy. A traditional village fair is held every year, starting from Poush Sankranti day on 14th January.

Maithon :

A hydel power project as well as a Dam of DVC has been constructed on the river Damodar. Nature here is panoramic. It is 26 km from Asansol and 9 km from Barakar Railway Station. Tourist Hotel and Guest House of DVC are available.

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Kumar Mangalam Park, Durgapur :

A beautiful park covering an area of 80 acres, designed and maintained by Durgapur Steel Plant. There is a beautiful lake having an area of 10.5 acres, and equipped with colourful fountains and boating facility.

Troika Park at City Center, Durgapur :

It has a Toy Train, Boating Lake and Rope Way facilities.

Durgapur Barrage :

It is an irrigation project of DVC, constructed on river Damodar at Durgapur. It is 3 km. away from Durgapur Railway Station.

La Mere Park, Burnpur :

It is situated by the side of river Damodar and about 3 km. from Burnpur Railway Station.

Nachan Dam Theme Park :

This is an entertainment park, having arrangement for Boating, Picnic etc. It is about 10 Km. from City Centre of Durgapur.

Other places of Religious/Tourist interest like Bishnupur, Massenjore Dam, Tarapith, Bakreswar etc. in Bankura and Birbhum districts are within 60 to 150 kms. from the urban centers of this region.

Cinema Houses :

There are 23 cinema houses in Asansol Sub-Division and 11 in Durgapur Sub-Division.

NATURAL FEATURES & RESOURCES :

The region is bounded on three sides by the three rivers namely Damodar that flows from N-W to S-E, Ajoy which flows from N-W to S-E, and Barakar that flows from N-E to S-W on the western periphery. There are other rivulets like Kunur, Nunia, Tamla and Singheran, which criss-cross the region. The region has a rolling topography, with the soil ranging from Red Laterite to Vindhya Alluvium in nature. Coal basin of Asansol Raniganj Coal Belt is the prime importance of ADDA jurisdiction.

CLIMATE AND RAINFALL :

Months of March to May is dry summer intervened by tropical cyclones and storms. June to September is rainy season while October and November is autumn. The winter season sets in the middle of November and continues till the middle of February. The laterite zone in the western part experiences very high temperature in summer and very low temperature in winter. The temperature on an average ranges from 26°C to 37.2°C during summer and from 26.4°C to 13.1°C during winter season. The maximum and minimum temperatures vary between 40°C to 42°C and 6°C to 8°C. The average annual rainfall is 1400 mm.

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PROFILE OF THE REGION :

ACCESSIBILITY :

All the urban centers of this region are easily accessible by road and rail links. The National Highway No 2 (G.T.Road) connects this region with Kolkata and Delhi. The Eastern Railway Main line connecting Kolkata and Delhi also passes through this region. The NH-2 has been widened to 4-lane capacity and is connected with Durgapur Expressway, which has considerably reduced the journey time to Kolkata. The region is also connected with Haldia, North Bengal and South-East resource region through a myriad of rail and road links.

CONNECTIVITY:

By Rail

Durgapur is 2 hrs. journey from Howrah by Satabdi Express and 16 hrs journey from Delhi by Rajdhani Express. Asansol is 2 hrs 30 min journey from Howrah and 15 hrs journey from Delhi. Raniganj is 2 hrs. 15 min Journey from Howrah by Satabdi Express and about 16 hrs journey from Delhi by Rajdhani Express.

By Road

Durgapur is accessible from Kolkata in 3 hrs. 15 min Raniganj is reachable from Kolkata in 3 hrs. 30 minis.

By Air

Durgapur Steel Plant (SAIL) Authority has laid a small airstrip at Durgapur, which can be utilized for passenger and goods movement. IISCO at Asansol is also having a small airstrip. An airport at Andal near Durgapur along with an Aerotropolis is under planning.

Planning Initiatives of ADDA :

OBJECTIVE

To provide planned development of rural and urban areas under its jurisdiction and for matters connected therewith or incidental thereto.

- Preparation of City Development Plan: Asansol Urban Agglomeration has been selected as “Mission City” under Jawaharlal Nehru National Urban Renewal Mission (JNNURM). The “City Development Plan” of entire area

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consisting of all five Municipal bodies have been prepared along with the vision documents and the same have been duly approved by Government of India.

- Preparation of Perspective Plan - 2025: Indian Institute of Technology has been engaged by ADDA for the preparation of perspective Plan-2025 for Asansol Durgapur Planning Area. The final document has been prepared and is the basis for ADDAs planning.
- Land Acquisition Planning: In order to meet the ever increasing demand for residential and industrial land, ADDA is presently involved in extensive planning for Land acquisition at Durgapur, Raniganj and Asansol.
- Local area Master Plan (Kulti, Panagarh): Indian Institute of Technology has prepared the Master Plan of Kulti and Master Plan of Panagarh for overall development of that area.

- Notification regarding framing of Industrial Zone for the Andal (G), J.L. No. 52, Dignala, J.L. No. 43, Madanpur, J.L. No, 48, Palashban, J.L. No, 47, Kajora, J.L. No. 41 and Ramprasadpur, J.L. No. 51 under Andal P.S, published on 10.10.2006.

MAIN POWERS AND FUNCTIONS :

ADDA is empowered to exercise the statutory functions :

- Prepare present Land use MAP & Registers,
- Prepare and enforce Land use and Development Control Plan.
- Prescribe use of Land within its area of Jurisdiction.

ADDA co-ordinates with the development activities of all departments and agencies of State Government or Local Authorities within its Planning Area. ADDA promote Industries and other economic activities by providing roads and other infrastructures, takes up comprehensive Area Development Plans for development of industrial estate transportation and communication services, commercial facilities, housing and social infrastructures.

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SPHERE OF ACTIVITY :

ADDA has taken up comprehensive Area Development Schemes both for development of Industries and Townships. In the Industrial Zones it develops plots with road and other infrastructures and offers plot to large medium and small industries.

For Small industries, water lines and electrical supply network are provided by ADDA. In case of large and medium industries ADDA coordinates with the Durgapur Projects Ltd and DMC to make available water and with DPL, DVC and WBSEB to make available power to industries in areas under their commands respectively.

In township areas ADDA develops residential plots of different size for allotment to individuals Group Housing Cooperatives Govt. Offices and same Govt. Offices, industries and business companies etc. It provides roads and all others Infrastructure and public amenities.

ADDA also takes up Comprehensive Area Development schemes for developing business and commercial facilities. ADDA lays stress on developing land for creation of social infrastructure like schools, colleges, guest houses and amusement parks etc.

ADDA consistently develops rural urban linkages and provides drainage, sewerage, water supply, public utilities, irrigation etc, to the urban, rural and fringe areas out of its own fund as well as from the Government fund.

SURVEY WORKS :

ADDA has taken up a large amount of survey work to create a basic for it's planning. Survey work includes topographic and contour surveys.
